**RE: Marngrook Oval, Diamond Creek
Local Road and Community Infrastructure Works**

I refer to Council's letter dated 25 November 2021 regarding proposed works at the Marngrook Oval in Diamond Creek.

To complement recent upgrades in the area, including Marngrook Pavilion, Diamond Creek Regional Playground, and the netball pavilion and courts, Council is undertaking works around Marngrook Oval to create a safer road environment and network for pedestrians and motorists.

Thank you to everyone who provided feedback to the proposal, which has helped to inform the updated design.

I am pleased to advise that Council officers have now completed site investigations and gathered the necessary information to conduct the tender process and appoint contractors to complete the works.

The works will include the following:

- linemarking and signage installation;
- a new footpath connection between the pavilion and the child care centre;
- installation of road humps;
- a new water fountain and bicycle repair station on concrete stand;
- placement of bollards and logs; and
- sealed asphalt car parking areas, including safety delineation with shared paths.

These works will result in more sealed parking spaces and a greater number of parking spaces overall. Please note that the existing informal parking spaces that run parallel to Main-Hurstbridge Road will be retained.

Additional consideration will also be given to pedestrian movement connecting Marngrook Pavilion and Main Hurstbridge Road, subject to final planning and budget.

Council has taken measures to minimise the impact on vegetation. Please note that during construction, Council will have an arborist on-site to supervise works around trees to monitor and support the mitigation of vegetation impacts.

We anticipate the works to have minimal disruption to the normal operations at the oval. Through traffic and access will be retained and managed on site and works limited to only during the daytime hours and on weekdays.

Works are now ready to commence and will run through to 30 June 2022. Council will start with signs, linemarking, footpath, kerb and road hump works in May. Asphalt works within the car park area will likely commence in June along with installation the new water fountain and bollards.

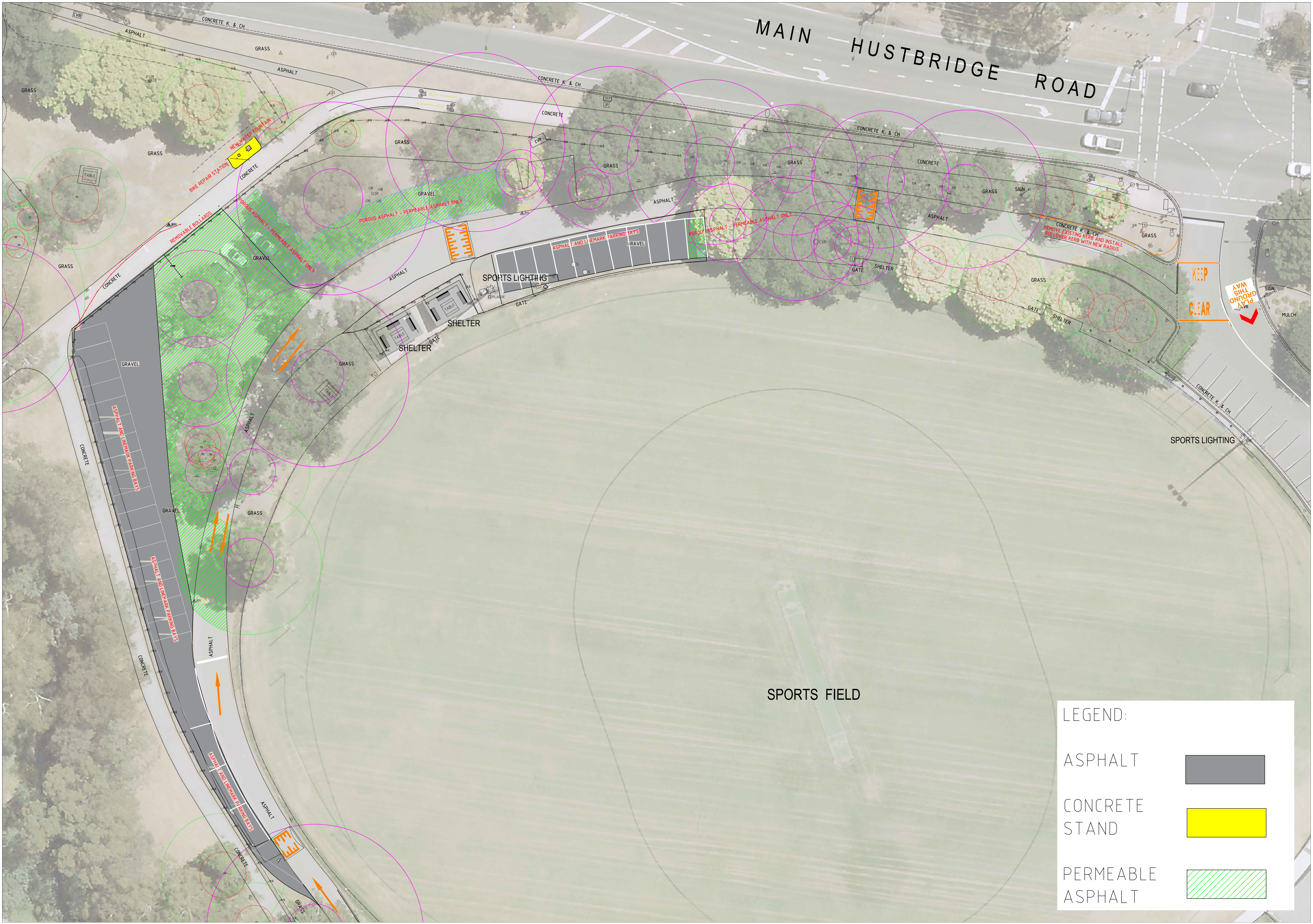

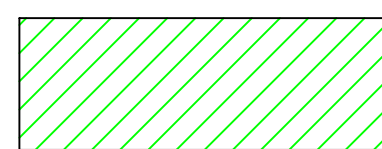
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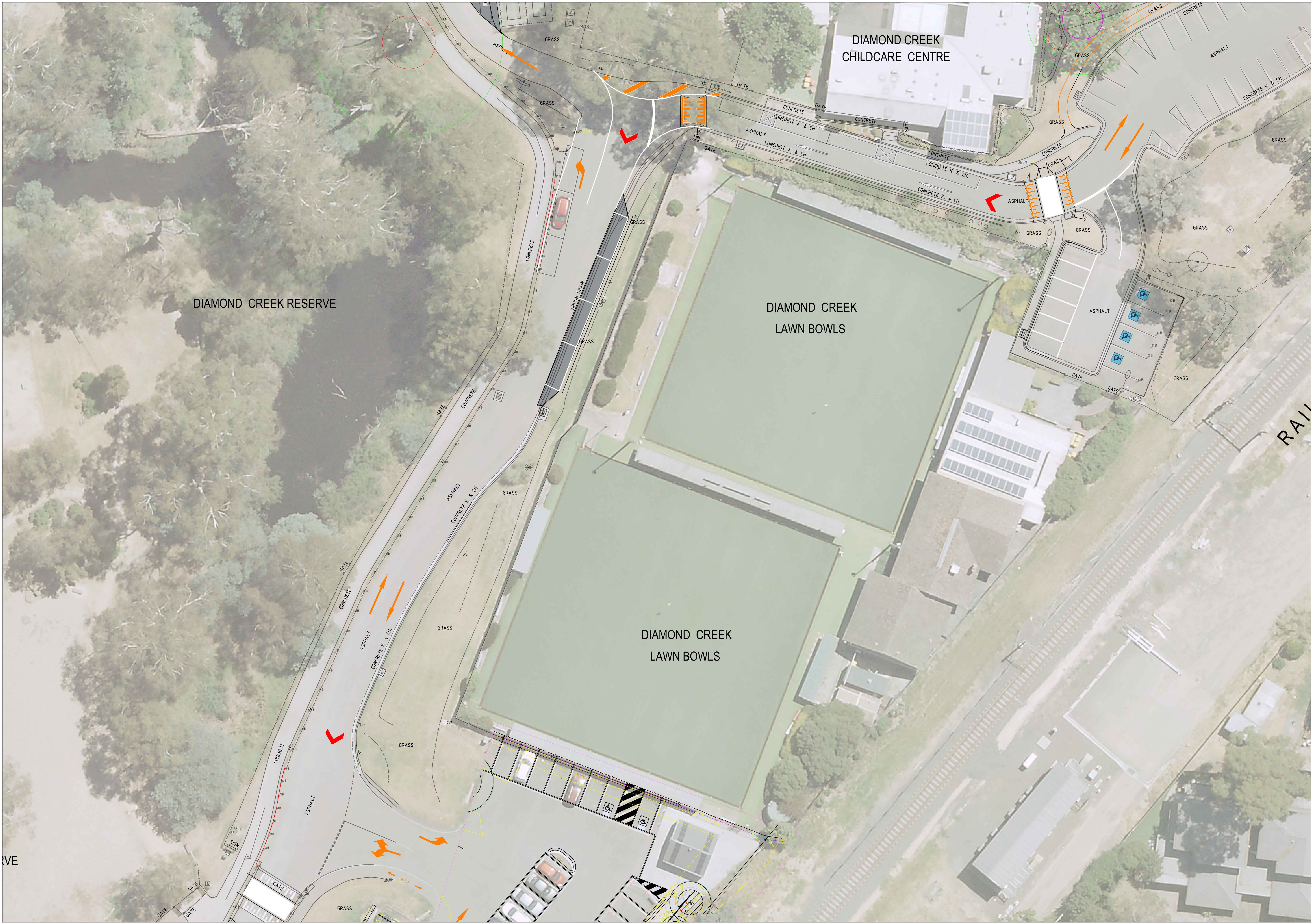
